## OVERVIEW

Advanced First Aid provides participants with more specialised first aid skills. Participants will learn how to utilise advanced first aid equipment, how to stabilise a casualty and operate a defibrillator in order to maintain life in an adult casualty in cardiac arrest.

This course also includes the Senior First Aid Refresher curriculum.
