OVERVIEW

Caring for Kids First Aid is designed to meet the first aid needs of parents, grandparents and other carers who are entrusted with the care of children and babies. The course provides valuable life skills in a non confronting environment and babies are welcome.

Caring for Kids First Aid training covers:

DRABCD Action Plan	Choking, Chest Pains and Asthma
Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)	Anaphylaxis and poisons
Unconscious child or baby	Wounds, Bleeding, Burns and Scalds
Safety in the home	Shock
Head injuries	Childhood illnesses

AWARD

Upon completion of this course, students will be awarded a Statement of Attendance:

Provide Basic Emergency Life Support

ASSESSMENT

There is no formal assessment for this course. Trainers will provide feedback and support during practical scenarios to develop skills of students.

DURATION
