## OVERVIEW

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation training will provide you with the skills to recognise and manage a casualty who is unconscious and is not breathing. CPR is a life saving technique which can sustain life until an ambulance arrives. St John recommends, in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines, that CPR training is undertaken every twelve months to maintain skills.
